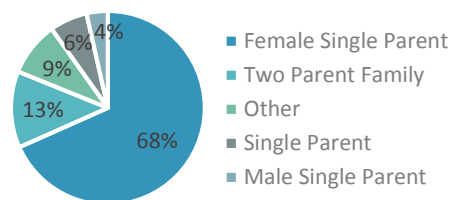


## Housing Status

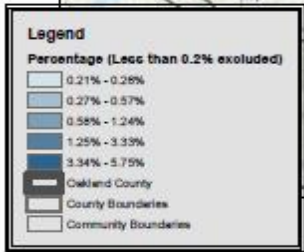
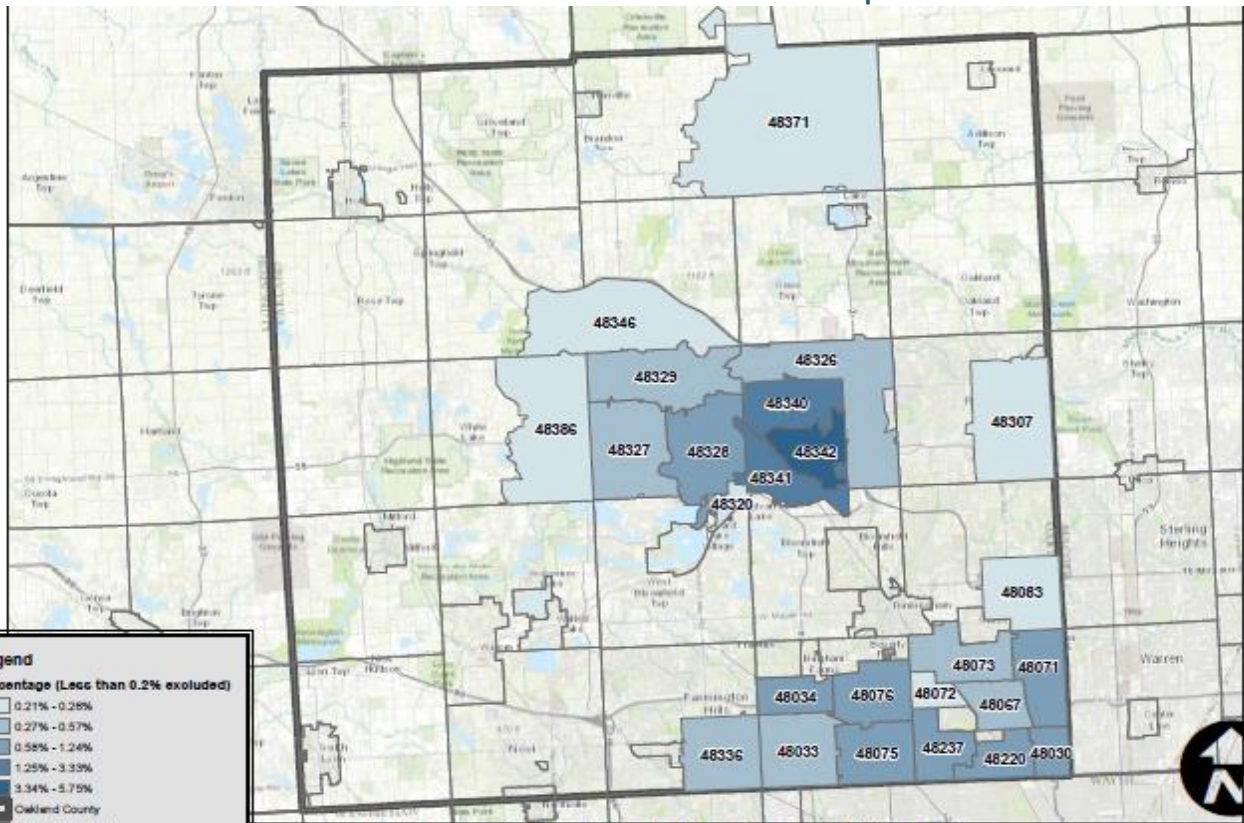

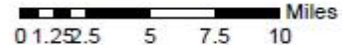

## Distribution of Total Clients Prior Residence Zip Code

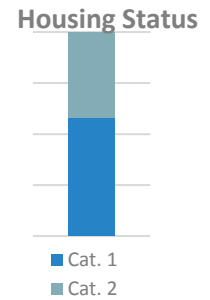
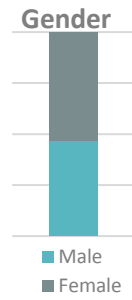
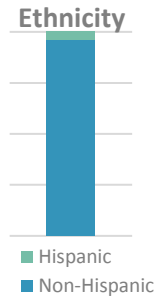
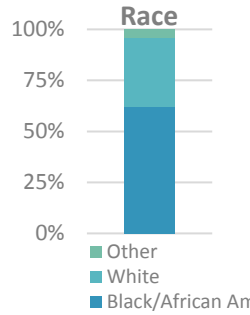

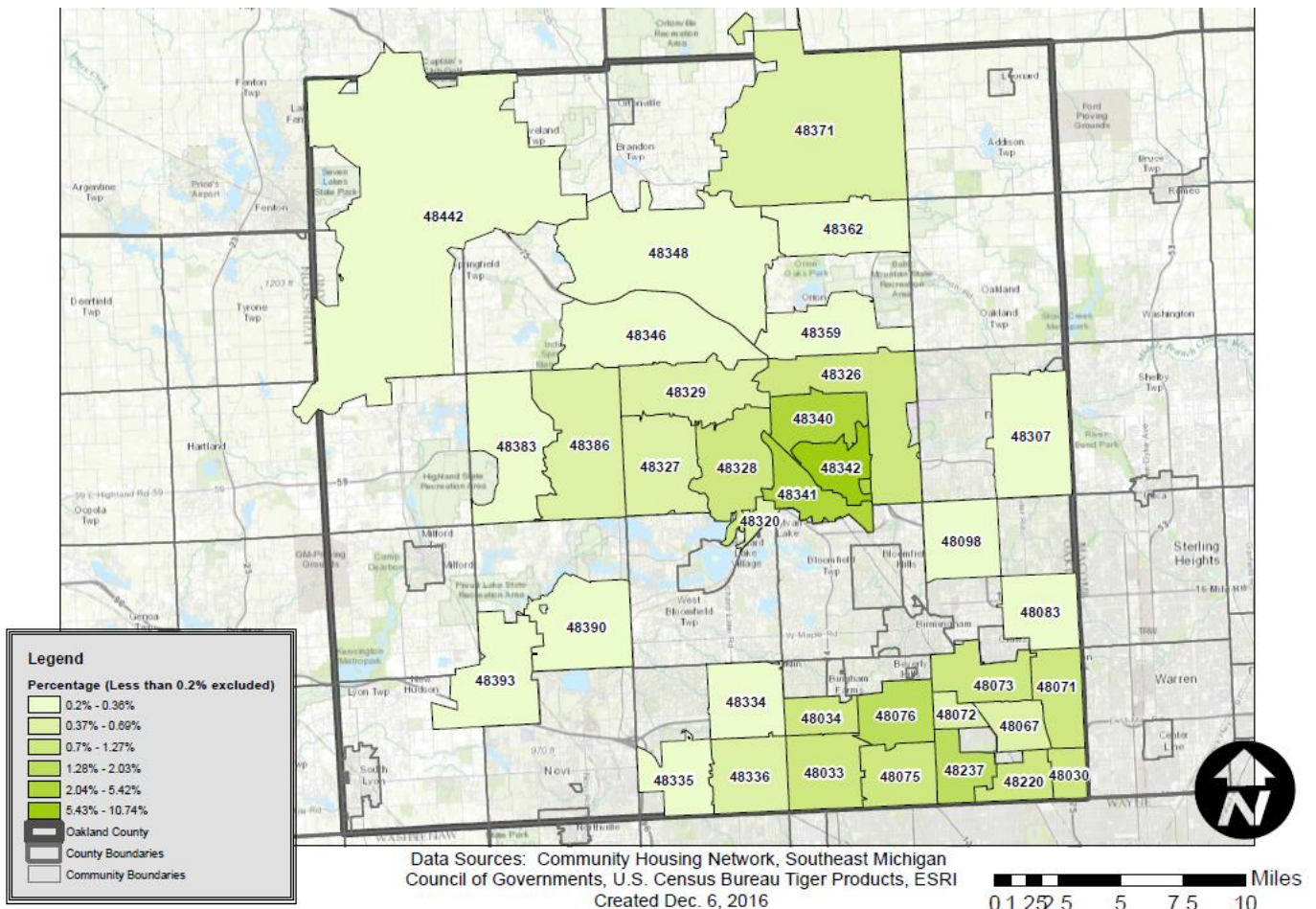

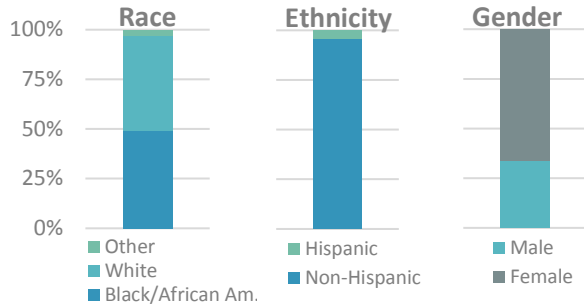

## Distribution of Homeless Clients Prior Residence Zip Code

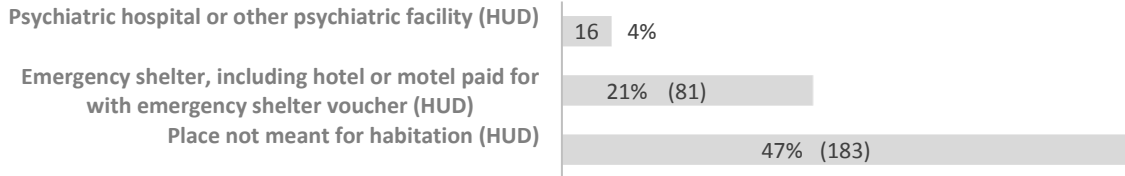
