Analysis Presentation by Brittany Coronado

- Brittany reviewed Gap Analysis survey results regarding Coordinated Entry, Resources, Landlords, and Employment:
 - Coordinated Entry scored Neutral in communication, timely response, adequate referrals, understanding no guarantee, comprehensive assessment, and diversion.
 - Resource accessibility scored high in food & medical coverage and low in transportation & childcare.
 - Top 3 additional resources needed are: transportation, increased income, mental health.
 - Landlord willingness, understanding, and rate reduction scored neutral.
 - Employment scored in agreement in adequate tools, understanding their role (case managers rated neutral in these categories). Case load scored neutral, and equivalent pay scored low across the board.
 - The highest concern for employee retention is inadequate wage compensation, which is also the top reason for departure.
 - Landlords/housing was ranked the top need to be addressed first.
- Group discussed the survey results and provided feedback.
- Next recommended step is to invite a wider group to the table to answer the survey questions; share the survey link at agency staff meetings for staff to answer the questions anonymously.
